

Digital Archiving and Electronic Publishing Agreement

This Agreement is entered into by and between:

- **First Party:** The Management of Egerto Digital Library (Operator of the approved OMP publishing system).
- **Second Party (Researcher/Author):** Mr./Ms. _____, in their capacity as the intellectual and legal owner of the academic work titled:

Preamble

Whereas the First Party provides a robust and sustainable digital environment dedicated to preserving, archiving, and publishing distinguished scientific and literary output (theses, dissertations, and graduation research) immediately after successfully passing the scientific committee's defense; and whereas the Second Party desires to archive and publish their work through this platform, both parties have mutually agreed to the following terms and conditions:

Article 1: Intellectual Property Rights and Academic Licensing

1. **Retention of Intellectual Property:** The Second Party (the Researcher) retains full intellectual property rights to their work. This agreement does not entail any waiver or transfer of these rights to the First Party (the Library).
2. **Open Access:** The Second Party agrees to make their work available free of charge and in full to readers and the public worldwide through the First Party's platform to support the global open access movement.
3. **Approved International License:** The scientific output is officially archived and made available under the Creative Commons International License: **Creative Commons (CC BY-NC-ND 4.0)**.
Protection under this license: This international license allows the public to download and share your research provided that you are clearly credited as the original author. It strictly prohibits modifying the research, deriving any parts from it, or exploiting it commercially or for profit by any entity.

Article 2: Technical Fees and Purpose of Payment

1. The Second Party commits to paying a flat, one-time fee upon uploading the work, amounting to **(5 USD)** or its equivalent in local currency.
2. The Second Party acknowledges and agrees that these fees are non-profit and are entirely allocated to cover the following operational and maintenance costs:
 - Sustaining infrastructure and hosting secure cloud servers for the OMP system to ensure the academic work remains accessible online for life.
 - Compensating the administrative and technical team responsible for system maintenance, cybersecurity, and data protection, as well as developing internal indexing tools.
 - Technical review, auditing, and metadata classification to ensure swift indexing and appearance in global scientific search engines.

Article 3: Order Cancellation and Refund Policy

Financial and administrative transactions between both parties are governed by the following rules:


Procedural Status of the Request	Official Financial and Administrative Action
After the start of technical review and initial upload of the thesis/dissertation	Fees are strictly non-refundable , as the library's technical resources and human effort are immediately allocated to process and technically adjust the file.
Rejection of the file for organizational reasons before processing begins	Fees are fully refundable . Immediate contact will be made with the researcher to return the amount via the payment method used.

Article 4: Warranties and Legal Liability

The Second Party declares and warrants that the uploaded work is the product of their own scientific effort and that it has successfully passed the prescribed academic defenses and examinations. The Second Party bears sole legal and ethical liability in the event of plagiarism or infringement on the intellectual property rights of others, without any liability whatsoever falling upon the First Party (the Library).
